OVERVIEW

Do you have a passion for communication and yoga? As the Editor of *Spectrum*, the BWY's magazine, you'll play a key role in connecting our community. *Spectrum* is more than just a publication – it's how we share important updates between trustees, committee members, volunteers, and our membership. It's also a platform for spreading BWY's values and work beyond our immediate community.

In this role, you'll take ownership of *Spectrum* published three times a year, managing everything from evolving the creative direction to the final production. You'll liaise with BWY's leadership to ensure key articles are included and commission engaging content that reflects the diversity and depth of our organization. If you love bringing stories to life, this could be the perfect opportunity for you!

Key responsibilities:

- Lead the planning and production of each edition.
- Commission, organise, and edit content to fit our editorial criteria.
- Collaborate with BWY leaders to highlight important projects and initiatives.
- Provide an outline of proposed articles for upcoming issues.

LOCATION:	This is a remote working role requiring a quiet space and fast wifi. Regular online and in-person team meetings. Some travel within the UK will be required occasionally.

DUTIES:

- Lead the planning and production of each edition.
- Use Adobe DTP software, particularly InDesign and Photoshop, to design and finalise layouts you create.
- Commission, organise, and edit content to fit our editorial criteria.
- Collaborate with BWY leaders to highlight important projects and initiatives.
- Provide an outline of proposed articles for upcoming issues.
- To consider at every opportunity the graphics and high-quality professional photos that may be available to go with articles.
- Creating social media posts from magazine content with BWY's Digital Officer
- To encourage contributors and Spectrum writers to take or obtain these high-quality images wherever possible.
- The Spectrum Editor will liaise with our printers
- Manage advertisements in Spectrum.
- You'll be responsible to the Head of Communications and Engagement who will act as the postholder's Editor in Chief, offering support and advice on overall BWY strategic mission.

Other duties

- Spectrum Editor will give input to the review of the national BWY website and social media activity, alongside the Communications and Engagement team.
- Attendance at team meetings (from time to time) to cultivate contacts with other members of staff and to retain integration of the BWY team.
- The postholder will be required to travel from time to time, for meetings and events, but this is a home-based role.

Suitable DTP equipment and software access supplied, plus free membership of BWY during your employment.

Qualifications and Training

- Solid journalism skills and knowledge of publishing law
- A minimum of three years' experience in a similar role

Skills and Experience

- Knowledge of yoga
- Proof-reading copy and editing
- Layout skills and knowledge of InDesign and other Adobe software packages
- High quality editorial skills, including interviewing, fact checking, the ability to w rite clear, engaging copy that needs little editing, copy editing, proof reading and a good design sense
- Commissioning photography
- An ability to build and manage contacts
- Ability to manage conflicting priorities
- Ability and desire to strive to find out new ways of delivering high quality content
